Independence Day Celebration, 2021

Today, the 15th of August, 2021 the college observed Independence Day in the college premises as part of *Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav* initiative. There were around 30 participants including students and faculty members. At the start of the celebration, Dr. Dhruuba Kr. Pathak, a facultu in the department of Assamese gave a deliberation about the purpose of the gathering and then felicitated Dr. Pradip Das, the Principal of the college with a traditional Assamese *gamosa* on behalf of the student and teacher community of BBK College. He then requested the Principal to deliver a short speech and also to hoist the flag. The Principal gave a short speech about the necessity to celebrate the occasion and the importance of the day. He also requested the ones present to pay tribute to the freedom fighters. The NCC cadets assisted him to the flag point and then he hoisted the flag and everyone sang the National Anthem.
