NEP 2020 based FYUGP Curriculum under Bhattadev University

Following the order of the Honourable Governor of Assam, B.B.K. College is affiliating under the Bhattadev University from the academic session 2024-25. The college will follow the NEP 2020 based curriculum framed by the Bhattadev University and offers FUYGP with the options mentioned below:

- ✓ Students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the first year.
- ✓ Students who opt to exit after completion of the second year and have secured 80 credits will be awarded the diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the second year.
- ✓ Students who opt to exit after completion of the third year and have secured 120 credits will be eligible for the bachelor in the major discipline without honours.
- ✓ Students after completion of the fourth year and have secured 160 credits will be eligible for the bachelor with honours in the major discipline.
- ✓ Students are allowed to re-enter the programme within three years and complete the programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.



Outline of Courses:

The broad categories of courses and minimum credits required for the 4-year Honours s as per the UGC document are as follows:

- 1. Major (Core) course/paper:** 80 credits
- 2. Minor course/paper:** 32 credits
- 3. Interdisciplinary course/paper (IDC):** 9 credits
- 4. Ability Enhancement Course/paper (AEC):** 8 credits
- 5. Skill Enhancement Course/paper (SEC):** 9 credits
- 6. Value Added Course/paper (VAC):** 8 credits
- 7. Summer Internship:** 2 credits
- 8. Research Project/ Dissertation:** 12 credits (for Honours with Research)

The following points may be noted:

- In lieu of the Research Project, a student may study 3 courses each of 4 credits (i.e. total 12 credits), leading to an Honours (without Research).
- For the 4-year Honours s the Major subject/ discipline requires 80 credits and the . Minor subject/ discipline requires 32 credits.
- For a Double Major, the minimum credit requirements are 48 (3-year) and 60 (4- year Honours) respectively in a subject/ discipline other than the original Major.
- In the UGC framework, papers in Major and Minor disciplines are categorized into levels of 100, 200, 300 and 400. Therefore, a course (paper) offered by a Department, say with 4 credits and of level 200, may be taken both as a Major (Core) course by one student and as a Minor course by another student having a different Major discipline, possibly in different semesters.

Some Important terms

Credit: A unit by which the course work is measured. It determines the number of hours of instructions required per week.

Theory/Tutorial classes: 1 credit = 1 hour / week, and

Practical classes: 1 credit = 2 hours / week

Credit Point: It is the product of grade point and number of credits for a course.

Letter Grade: It is an index of the performance of students in a said course.

Grade Point: It is a numerical weight allotted to each letter grade on a certain point scale.

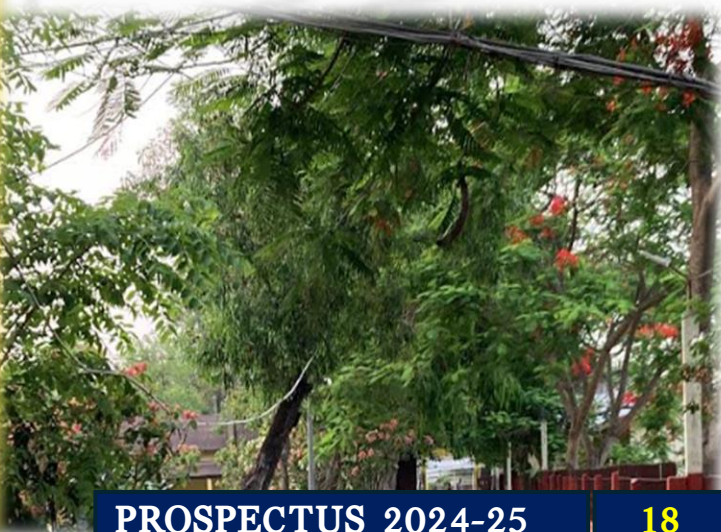

The College has an excellent Library and Information Centre, one of the institution's central support services. The library has been carefully designed to provide a comfortable seating and reading environment with proper light and air conditioners. It's a spacious premise comprising an area of 2795 sq feet. The library has the capacity of sitting more than 70 readers in total with the provision of separate reading rooms for students and teachers. There is also a dedicated digital room for accessing e-documents & internet in the library and a beautifully designed periodical section with group discussion tables.

The library has a boasting collection of more than 16000 physical books and other resources. Currently, the library is subscribing to one peer-reviewed journal in physical format, 8 Magazines and 3 Newspapers. The library also preserves some valuable old and rare manuscripts collected from the localities. The library is subscribing to N-List & NDLi services which provides free access to more than 2 lacs e-books and 6000 e-journals. The Library has its own Digital Library over Cloud server to store and provide online access to e-resources created and collected by the college.

The Library is automated using KOHA software. All the issue return processes are operated through the software using barcode printed ID Card. The library has its own OPAC for catalogue searching, Online Attendance system and a dedicated webpage. To enhance security, the library is equipped with CCTV system. The library provides reprographic services to the students. As part of the automation and digitization, the library has a tabletop scanner for the digitization process. The library has a Laser printer and a barcode printer and four scanner for the automation purpose.

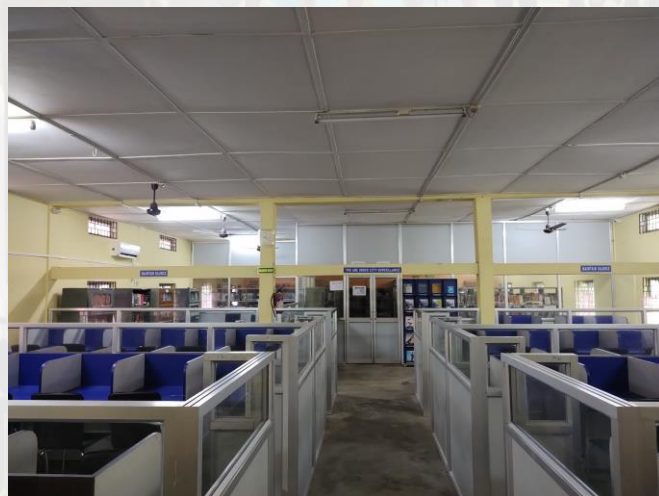

Physical Facilities

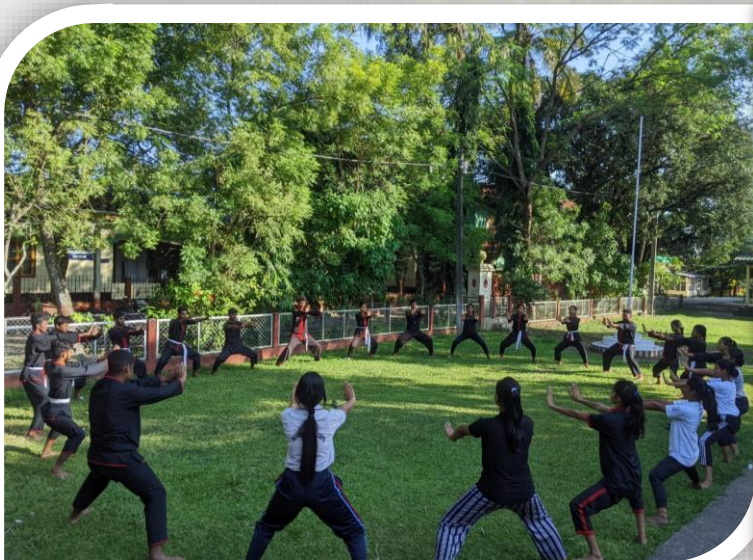
